Proficiency in personal computer database programs such as Word, Quickbooks, Windows XP professional, MS Word, Excel and Outlook. Must be able to create database queries and generate professional reports from database.

Proficiency and experience in writing roofing specifications according to industry standards and performing job cost analysis and cash flow analysis in a professional manner.

Experience with the following types of commercial and residential waterproofing and roofing systems:

Built-up, modified asphalt, metal panel, asphalt shingle, state, tile, EPDM, PVC, CPE, Foam and Elastomeric.

Climbing stairs, ladders and scaffolding, and working at heights above thirty feet.

Oversees extent of damages and determines if repair can be completed.
